**RESOLUTION NO. 06**

The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Huntington, Indiana (“Commissioners”), in meeting duly assembled, now finds:

WHEREAS, the City of Huntington, Indiana (“City”) owns personal property, which it has determined to be surplus and no longer needed, specifically consisting of:

- Ten (10) Motorola HT-1000 VHF portable handheld radios including batteries;
- Ten (10) battery chargers;
- Ten (10) label microphones; and
- Five (5) additional batteries

(collectively “Personal Property”);

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. § 5-22-22-10, the City, by and through its Board of Public Works & Safety, may transfer the Personal Property to the County of Huntington, Indiana (“County”) upon agreeable terms evidenced by each adopting a substantially identical resolution;

WHEREAS, the County, by and through its Commissioners, for the use of the Huntington County Sheriff’s Department, is willing to purchase the Personal Property for \$750.00, an amount with which the City agrees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City shall transfer the Personal Property to the County for a total of \$750.00. The City shall warrant title of the Personal Property, but otherwise the exchange is made without warranty and is an “as is” transfer.
