ORDINANCE NO. 2012-25

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN PUBLIC-WAY LOCATED IN HUNTINGTON COUNTY, INDIANA.

An ordinance adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County, Indiana, and meeting duly assembled of the 30th day of July, 2012, as follows:

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of this Board, held on the 30th day of July, 2012, the Board considered a Petition to Vacate that was filed by Janet Sue Heaston seeking vacation of a portion of an unimproved, platted 40' wide street and unimproved, platted 14' wide alleys. Said portion of the unimproved, platted 40' wide street to be vacated lies between lots Numbered 5,9, 12, 15, 18, 21, 24, and 27 in Edwin T. Brown's South Side City Park Addition to the City of Huntington, Huntington Township, in Huntington County, Indiana. Said portion of the unimproved, platted 14' wide alley to be vacated is that portion between lots Numbered 1-5, and lots 8-9, between lots Numbered 8, 11, 14, 17, 20 and lots Numbered 91, 12, 15, 18, 21, and between lots Numbered 20 and 23, and between lots Numbered 21 and 24, and between lots Numbered 23 and 26 and lots Numbered 24 and 27 in Edwin T. Brown's South Side City Park Addition to the City of Huntington, Huntington Township, in Huntington County, Indiana.

WHEREAS, a regular meeting of this Board, held on the 30th day of July, 2012, being within thirty (30) days after the filing of said petition on July 23, 2012, this Board conducted a public hearing on said petition;

WHEREAS, due notice of said public hearing was published according to law pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-7-3-12(c)(1); and

WHEREAS, due notice of said public hearing to all other owners of land abutting said portion of the platted street and alley was sent via certified mail to the abutting land owners; and

WHEREAS, said portion of the unimproved platted street and alley sought to be vacated are located in Huntington County, Indiana, and outside the corporate boundaries of any municipality, and this Board has proper jurisdiction over the proceedings herein; and

WHEREAS, there being no objectors or remonstrators to said petition, that portion of the unimproved platted street and alley being vacated, the Board now finds that the vacation of said street and alley would not:

- Hinder the growth or orderly development of the unit or neighborhood in which said unimproved platted street and alley is located;
- Make access to the lands of any person by means of public-way difficult or inconvenient;

- Hinder the public's access to a church, school, or other public building or place; or
- Hinder the use of a public-way by the neighborhood of which said unimproved platted s treet and alley are located or to which they are contiguous.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County, Indiana, as follows:

That the following described portion of an unimproved, platted 40' wide street and unimproved, platted 14' wide alleys be vacated: Said portion of the unimproved, platted 40' wide street between lots Numbered 5,9, 12, 15, 18, 21, 24, and 27 in Edwin T. Brown's South Side City Park Ad dition to the City of Huntington, Huntington Township, in Huntington County, Indiana. Said portion of the unimproved, platted 14' wide alley between lots Numbered 1-5, and lots 8-9, between lots Numbered 8, 11, 14, 17, 20 and lots Numbered 91, 12, 15, 18, 21, and between lots Numbered 20 and 23, and between lots Numbered 21 and 24, and between lots Numbered 23 and 26 and lots Numbered 24 and 27 in Edwin T. Brown's South Side City Park Addition to the City of Huntington, Huntington Township, in Huntington County, Indiana.

That the Secretary of the Board is instructed to furnish a copy of this ordinance to the Recorder of Huntington County, Indiana, for recording, and to the Auditor of Huntington County, Indiana.
