ORDINANCE NO. 2013-09

AN ORDINANCE ESTAI LISHING AN ANNUAL SEX OR VIOLENT OFFENDER
REGISTRATION FEE, A SEX OR VIOLENT OFFENDER ADDRESS CHANGE FEE, AND
ESTABLISHING THE H JNTINGTON COUNTY SEX OR VIOLENT OFFENDER
ADMINISTRATION FUND

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County, Indiana ("Commissioners") is the exect ive and legislative body for Huntington County, Indiana;

WHEREAS, subject to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-13-5.6, the Commissioners may require the Huntington Country Sheriff to collect an annual sex or violent offender registration fee and a sex or violent offender address change fee; and,

WHEREAS, the Comm ssioners desire to establish the Huntington County Sex or Violent Offender Administration Fund to fund the administration of the sex or violent offender registration system.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County, Indiana, as follows:

- 1. There is hereby created fund to be known as the Huntington County Sexual Violent Offender Administration Fund. The purpose of the fund is to defray the expense of administering or ensuring compliance with the laws concerning the Indiana Sex and Violent Offender Regist y.
- 2. The annual fee for sex and violent offenders registering in Huntington County shall be Fifty Dollars (\$50.00). 'ayment of the fee shall be made upon the offender's initial registration in Huntington County and subsequently on or before each annual registration date.
- 3. A fee of Five Dollars (\$.00) shall be charged and collected each time a sex or violent offender registers an address change with the Huntington County Sheriff's Department.

All Fees collected under this ordinance shall be collected by the Huntington County Sheriff's Department when a set offender registers with the Huntington County Sheriff's Department.

All fees collected under his ordinance by the Huntington County Sheriff's Department shall be transferred to the Huntington County Auditor in a timely manner. On a monthly basis, the Huntington County Auditor shall:

(a) Deposit ninety percent (90%) of any fees collected under this ordinance in the Huntington County ex and Violent Offender Administration Fund; and

(b) Transfer ten percent (10%) of any fees collected under this ordinance to the Treasurer of the State of India a for deposit in the state sex and violent offender administration fund under Ind. Coc : §11-8-8-21.

The Huntington County Counsel shall appropriate money from the Huntington County Sex or Violent Offender Admir stration Fund to an agency or organization involved in the administration of the sex and volent offender registry to offset or defray the expense or administering or ensuring compliance with the laws concerning the Indiana sex and violent offender registry.
