ORDINANCE NO. 2013-24

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A CERTAIN PUBLIC-WAY LOCATED IN HUNTINGTON COUNTY, INDIANA

An Ordinance adopted by the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County,

Indiana, in a meeting duly assembled on **November 18**, 2013, as follows:

WHEREAS, at the regular meeting of this Board, held on <u>September 23</u>, 2013, a Petition to Vacate was filed by Lori I. Nave seeking vacation of a portion of an unimproved platted street in Idle Hour Park located in Huntington County, Indiana, more particularly described as that portion of the 50' wide platted street between Lots 61 and 62.

WHEREAS, at a regular meeting of this Board, held on November 4, 2013, being within thirty (30) days after the filing of said petition on September 17, 2013, and continued subsequently thereto, this Board conducted a public hearing on said Petition;

WHEREAS, due notice of said public hearing was published according to law pursuant to the revisions of I.C. §36-7-3-12(c)(1) and I.C. § 5-3-1-2; and

WHEREAS, due notice of said public hearing to all other owners of land abutting said portion of the platted street was sent via certified mail to the abutting land owners; and

WHEREAS, said portion of the unimproved platted street sought to be vacated is located in Huntington County, Indiana, and outside the corporate boundaries of any municipality, and this Board has proper jurisdiction over the proceedings herein; and

WHEREAS, the objections to said Petition having been heard and considered concerning that portion of the unimproved platted street being vacated, the Board now finds that the vacation of said street would not:

1. Hinder the growth or orderly development of the unit or neighborhood in which said

unimproved platted street is located;

2. Make access to the lands of any person by means of public-way difficult or inconvenient;

3. Hinder the public's access to a church, school, or other public building or place; or

4. Hinder the use of a public-way by the neighborhood of which said unimproved platted

street are located or to which they are contiguous.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of Huntington

County, Indiana, as follows:

That the following described portion of the unimproved platted street in Idle Hour Park

located in Huntington County, Indiana would be, and the same is hereby vacated, to-wit: the

portion of the unimproved platted 50' wide street between Lots numbered 61 and 62, which are

more specifically described on the attached Exhibit "A".

That the Secretary of the Board is instructed to furnish a copy of this Ordinance to the

Recorder of Huntington County, Indiana, for recording, and to the Auditor of Huntington County,

Indiana.

PETITION TO VACATE PUBLIC WAY

COMES NOW Petitioner, Lori I. Nave, by Counsel, Justin R. Wall, and petitions the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County, Indiana to vacate a section of the unimproved portion of Superior Street, located in Huntington County, Indiana and in support thereof states that:

- 1. Petitioner, Lori I. Nave, is the fee simple owner of Lots 62 and 63 in Idle Hour Park, located in Huntington County, Indiana as demonstrated in attached Exhibit "A".
- 2. Jeffrey A. Shipbaugh is the fee simple owner of Lots 57, 58, 59, 60 and 61 in Idle Hour Park, located in Huntington County, Indiana as demonstrated in attached Exhibit "B".
- 3. That directly between the parcels owned by the Petitioner, Lori I. Nave, and Jeffrey A. Shipbaugh there is an unimproved platted 50' wide street named "Superior Street." Said portion of the unimproved platted 50' wide street to be vacated is the 100' portion of Superior Street between Lots 61 and 62 and is best shown in attached Exhibit "C".
- 4. That the property proposed to be vacated is specifically described as shown in attached Exhibit "D".

- 5. The names and addresses of all owners of land that abut that part of the unimproved platted street to be vacated are as follows:

- 6. The vacation of said unimproved platted street would not hinder the growth or orderly development of Huntington County or the neighborhood in which the same is located or to which the same are contiguous.
- 7. The vacation of said unimproved platted street would not hinder the use of a public-way by the neighborhood in which the same is located or to which the same is contiguous.
- 8. That no adjoining or nearby property owner or other persons who have a need for the use of said portion of the unimproved platted street, or any part thereof, for ingress or egress to their respective properties or to any public street or right-of-way will be made difficult or inconvenient by reason of vacating said portion of said unimproved platted street.
- That no person or persons or other public at large will be damaged by the vacation of said portion of the unimproved platted street.
- 10. That there is no church, school, or other public building or place to which access by the public would be eliminated or hindered by reason of vacating said portion of the

unimproved platted street.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that after due notice of these proceedings and herein thereon, this Board adopt an ordinance vacating said portion of the unimproved portion of Superior Street located in Huntington County, Indiana and for all other relief just and proper in the premises.


