### ORDINANCE 2007-01

# (AFFECTING PRECINCTS HUNTINGTON 11A AND 4 AND JACKSON 1, 2 AND 3 TO ACCOMMODATE ANNEXATIONS TO ROANOKE AND HUNTINGTON)

Whereas, pursuant to Indiana Code 3-11-1.5, the Board of Commissioners is required to modify the boundaries of precincts in Huntington County in order to comply with the directives of Indiana Law; and,

Whereas, certain changes have occurred with legislative districts and municipal boundaries in Huntington County requiring the need to revise and update the existing precinct boundaries in Huntington County and to file with the Indiana Election Commission updated Precinct Summary Statements and updated Precinct Boundary Maps.

Whereas, a draft Precinct Establishment Order, updated Precinct Summary Statements and updated Precinct Boundary Maps were submitted to the Indiana Election Commission and approved by the Commission by Order 2007-2, dated January 31, 2007.

Now therefore, be it ordered by the Board of Commissioners of Huntington County as follows:

Huntington County, Indiana, by and through its Board of Commissioners hereby establishes voting precincts for the County as set forth in the Precinct Boundary Maps and Precinct Summary Statements made a part of this Order. Said Precinct Boundary Maps and Precinct Summary Statements shall be maintained by the Clerk of the Huntingotn Circuit Court.

The proposed precincts having been reviewed and approved by the Indiana Election Commission on January 31, 2007, shall become effective upon adoption of this Ordinance.

The Clerk shall file a copy of this Ordinance with the Indiana Election Commission within seven (7) days of adoption and shall publish notice of the Precinct Establishment Order as provided under Indiana Law and shall file a proof of publication with the Indiana Election Commission within forty-five (45) days after publication.
