

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-06

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR  
TO COLLECT FEES FOR REAL PROPERTY ENDORSEMENT

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Huntington,  
State of Indiana, in a meeting duly assembled that:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Indiana Code 36-2-11-14(a) the county recorder may record a deed of partition or conveyance of land only if it has been endorsed by the county auditor of the proper county as “duly entered for taxation subject to final acceptance for transfer”, “not taxable”, “duly entered for taxation”, or “filed” as provided in Indiana Code 36-2-9-18, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners desires to provide for specific fees with regard to each real property endorsement that the county auditor makes with respect to deeds of partition, conveyances of land as provided in Indiana Code 36-2-9-18(d), or for any other purpose.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Huntington, State of Indiana, that

(1) Pursuant to I.C. 36-2-9-18(d) the Board of Commissioners hereby establish a Plat Book Fund. The County Auditor is hereby authorized to collect a fee in the amount of Five Dollars (\$5.00) per each real estate parcel, per endorsement made for any purpose. Such revenues collected are hereby dedicated to the fund for the use of maintaining plat books. (2) This Ordinance amends, supercedes, and repeals Ordinance No. 2004-1.

(3) This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of June 1, 2008.


