

HUNTINGTON COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 2019- 04

An Ordinance Establishing Size and Weight Limits on Highways

WHEREAS, except as otherwise provided by law, a person may not operate or move upon a highway a vehicle or combination of vehicles of a size or weight that exceeds the limitations set forth on a sign posted upon or at the entrances to the highway or part of the highway that is affected; and

WHEREAS, the limitations governing vehicle size or weight on highways under the jurisdiction of the County are set forth in a document entitled "Huntington County Traffic Control Manual" which is to be maintained by the County Highway Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissions may approve, by motion made in open meeting, amendments of regulatory signs and restrictions to the list contained in the "Huntington County Traffic Control Manual", now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED that the Huntington County Highway Superintendent shall be authorized to install and maintain no class 8 truck traffic signs prohibiting the operation of certain truck vehicles along certain public roadways described herein as follows:

1. Class 8 truck traffic is prohibited on the following county roads:

<u>Public Roadway</u>	<u>Where Limit Applies</u>
County Road 900N	From the Roanoke town limits to State Road 9

2. Any person who shall intentionally and knowingly violate the provisions of this Ordinance shall be fined in the amount not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). Each violation shall constitute a separate offense.

3. This Ordinance shall not prohibit the operation of (a) Class 8 trucks making local pick-up or delivery; or (b) Class 8 trucks operated on officially established detours.

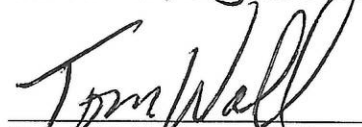
4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and required publication.
