ORDINANCE 10-C-22

Synopsis: This Ordinance, if adopted, would reduce certain water rates to account for the repeal of the utility receipts tax (URT) in accordance with House Enroll Act 1002.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 50.10 (A) and (B) OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA'S CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2022, Governor Holcomb signed House Enroll Act 1002 ("HEA 1002") into law; and

WHEREAS, HEA 1002, among other things, requires that a utility which is not subject to IURC jurisdiction adjust its rates and charges to reflect the repeal of the utility receipts tax; and

WHEREAS, the City employed its municipal advisor Baker Tilly to prepare calculations and schedules so the City may adjust its rates and charges so as to remain in compliance; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, that the Common Council of the City of Huntington, Indiana, in meeting duly assembled, after consideration of information and deliberation deemed by it to be sufficient, including conducting a public hearing, hereby amends the City of Huntington, Indiana's Code of Ordinances by deleting Sections 50.10 (A) and (B) in their entirety and replacing them with the following:

"§ 50.10 WATER RATES.

There are established for the use of and the service rendered by the Waterworks, the following rates and charges:

(A) Minimum Monthly Charges. Each User shall pay a minimum monthly charge, in accordance with the following chart, based upon the size of the installed meter. These minimum monthly charges include the fee assessed for the amounts included below in the columns titled "Included Usage". All usage in excess of these included usage amounts shall be assessed and payable pursuant to division (B), below:
