

## RESOLUTION 2-R-22

*Synopsis: This resolution, if adopted, would opt the City of Huntington back into the State of Indiana opioid settlement legislation pursuant to IC 4-6-15-2.*

### **RESOLUTION TO OPT BACK IN TO OPIOIDS SETTLEMENT PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 4-6-15-2**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Huntington, Indiana has been actively engaged in pursuing damages caused by the manufacture, sale, and distribution of opioids through outside counsel in multidistrict litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, recent legislation amending Indiana Code 4-6-15 has been adopted by the Indiana legislature and signed into law by the Governor; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Huntington, Indiana, after due consideration of said legislation, has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens to opt back in to the opioids' settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City of Huntington, Indiana that the City of Huntington, Indiana, having considered whether to elect to opt back in to the opioids settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2, hereby resolves that the City of Huntington now exercises its election to opt back in to the opioid settlements, and orders its duly authorized agent to submit a certified copy of this Resolution to the Indiana Attorney General by July 15, 2022.
