

ORDINANCE 5-C-22

Synopsis: This ordinance, if adopted, would provide additional funding to ARPA Fund: Unappropriated 2402-001-900, not to exceed \$87,000 for Police Radios and Earpieces, and General Fund: Police Motor Equipment 1101-010-441.

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, it has been determined that it is now necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget; and
