

ORDINANCE 21-C-23

Synopsis: This ordinance, if adopted, would amend Ordinance 17-C-23, elected and appointed official salary ordinance, to include payments to City Board of Public Works and Safety Members.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 17-C-23 OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2023, the Common Council of the City of Huntington, Indiana adopted Ordinance 17-C-23 setting the salaries of the elected officials of the City; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with information received from the Indiana State Board of Accounts, City Ordinance 17-C-23 should be amended to include payments to the City's Board of Public Works and Safety Members; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Huntington, Indiana in meeting duly assembled based on information deemed by Council to be sufficient, that Ordinance 17-C-23 of the City of Huntington, Indiana be and is hereby amended by adding the following:

“Board of Public Works and Safety Member (excluding Mayor and Common Council Member(s)):

The monthly sum of \$200 (General Fund)”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, Ordinance 17-C-23 is only amended by inclusion of the provisions above, the remaining portions of Ordinance 17-C-23 shall remain unchanged.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its adoption and in accordance with applicable law.
