AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA BY AMENDING SECTION 78.01(E): TRAFFIC SCHEDULE V – ONE-WAY STREETS, ALLEYS

The Common Council (“Council”) of the City of Huntington, Indiana (“City”) in meeting duly assembled and upon information deemed by it to be sufficient, finds as follows:

WHEREAS, the current direction of vehicle travel on the alley between East Johns Street and Roche Street should be amended and changed from two-way to one-way traveling westerly; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by Council that Section 78.01(E): *Traffic Schedule V – One-Way Streets, Alleys* is hereby amended by addition as follows:

E John Street and Roche Street	Westerly	Warren Street	N Jefferson Street

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED THAT, this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
