Maple Solar Projects

County Attorney Andrew Boxberger addressed questions raised by Marilyn Bradford during the previous commissioners' meeting. He explained that there is no legal course of action available that wouldn't expose the county to potential harm. If the county were to make changes, it could be held legally liable. Conversely, if the county were to rescind the agreement, the courts have indicated it would be considered a political action, arbitrary and capricious.

Maple Solar has until October 27, 2025, to initiate the project by pulling a permit. After that, they have 10 years to complete the project. To overturn or deny the signed agreement, there would need to be a significant and justifiable change in circumstances. If Maple Solar does not have a complete plan in place and fails to pull a permit with the DCD by the deadline, they will be required to reapply under the new County Solar Ordinance.
