

BPW&S RESOLUTION 2025-11

**BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY
OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA**

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Huntington, Indiana (“Board”), in meeting duly assembled and after considering information deemed by it to be sufficient, finds:

WHEREAS, the City of Huntington owns, maintains, and operates public parks some of which include ponds and City Code Section 99.08 generally prohibits swimming or otherwise entering City park ponds, however, City Code Section 99.14 provides that reasonable exceptions may be made by the Board by the adoption of a resolution; and

WHEREAS, Michael Daly of Holly, Michigan has requested that the Board issue such an exception to allow him to enter the ponds in Memorial Park for the limited purpose of retrieving disc golf discs and the Board finds that such an exception should be granted; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board that:

1. Michael Daly may enter City ponds located in Memorial Park for the express and limited purpose of retrieving disc golf discs.
2. Prior to entering any City pond, Michael Daly shall sign and return the attached and incorporated Release and Waiver of Liability, Assumption of Risk, and Indemnity Agreement (“Release”).
3. This exception terminates sixty (60) days from the execution of the attached Release unless earlier terminated by the City.
