REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY May 1, 2023

A quorum of the Board of Public Works & Safety (Board) being present, the Board met for its regular meeting on Monday, May 1, 2023, at 3:30 p.m., in accordance with all applicable requirements, notice, and authority.

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor Strick opened the Board of Public Works & Safety meeting.

Board Members present: Mayor Strick, Danielle Albertson, Dwight Brautigam, and Charles Chapman. Absent: Anthony Lisinicchia. Also present: Director of Engineering, Adam Cuttriss; Director of Community Development and Redevelopment, Bryn Keplinger; City Attorney, Michael Hartburg; and Clerk-Treasurer, Christi McElhaney.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: Board Member Brautigam moved to approve minutes of the April 17, 2023, regular meeting, seconded by Board Member Chapman. Motion passed 4-0. Minutes signed.

<u>OLD BUSINESS</u>: Director Keplinger recommends rejecting the bids that were received to reconstruct the Memorial Park Stone Raceway. Board Member Brautigam made a motion to follow the recommendation and reject all bids, seconded by Board Member Albertson. Motion passed 4-0.

Director Cuttriss presented **Change Order #2 for LTCP Project 9** to the Board for approval. The contractor, while digging a foundation to install a disinfecting building at the sewer plant, found buried debris that needed to be disposed of properly. **The cost to dispose of this debris is \$72,082.49**. Board Member Chapman made a motion to approve Change Order 2 and authorize the Mayor to sign, seconded by Board Member Brautigam. Motion passed 4-0. Mayor Strick signed the change order.

NEW BUSINESS:

Director Cuttriss presented an agreement with Exterior Excavating to install a new sewer line on Agnes Street between Oak Street and Lafontaine Street. The cost is \$32,885.00 and will be funded out of the Storm Water Bond funds. Board Member Brautigam made a motion to approve the agreement and authorize the Mayor to sign, seconded by Board Member Albertson. Motion passed 4-0. Mayor signed agreement.

Director Cuttriss presented an agreement with Snowball Excavating to install a new sewer line on Drover Street. The cost is \$23,231.75 and will be funded out of the Storm Water Bond funds. Board Member Albertson made a motion to approve the agreement and authorize the Mayor to sign, seconded by Board Member Chapman. Motion passed 4-0. Mayor signed agreement.

ACCOUNTS PAYABLE: Board Member Brautigam moved to pay the bills as presented, seconded by Board Member Chapman. Motion passed 4-0. Documentation signed.
