Please have the outside of the envelope marked as 'Certificate Sale' and on the memo line of the certified check please put your screen name. This will help us better to identify and efficiently process your payment.

If payment is not made by the winning bidder by the required time, the bidder is subject to a penalty of twenty-five percent (25%) of the amount bid. See IC 6-1.1-24-8.

If the county courthouse is open to the general public, you may make your payment in person. Payment will need to be by cash or certified check. Please call ahead to be certain that the Treasurer's Office is open to the public.
