

REGULAR SESSION OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL  
OF HUNTINGTON COUNTY INDIANA  
APRIL 22, 2019, COUNTY COUNCIL MEETING

The Huntington County Council met in regular session the 22nd day of April, 2019, in the G.A.R. Room of the Huntington County Courthouse, Huntington, Indiana, at 7:00 P.M for the purpose of considering all business brought before it pursuant to notice given to the Huntington Herald Press, April 12th, 2019.

The meeting was opened with prayer by Terry Miller and the Pledge of Allegiance.

ITEM 1: Phil Hibbert made a motion to approve the March 25, 2019 Minutes. Ron Kline seconded and the motion passed 7-0.

ITEM 2: Troy Hostetler requested a correction to pay a claim out of CEDIT instead of MVH. Keith Eller made a motion to approve this request, Terry Miller seconded and the motion passed 7-0.

ITEM 3: Shelley Septer, Clerk of Courts originally requested an appropriation of funds in her 1119 Clerks Records Perpetuation fund, but it was determined that no action is needed for this request.

ITEM 4: Commissioner Rob Miller advised Council on the LIT Correctional Rehab request for an appropriation of \$1,100,000.00 in the 1233-000-30.0030 Jail Expansion Project. Rob showed a drawing of what the expansion may look like. Council discussed the issues they have and decided to appropriate \$228,000.00. Terry Miller made a motion to approve the \$228,000.00 to finish the schematic design. Ron Kline seconded and a roll call was taken Ron Kline – Yes, Phil Hibbert – Yes, Kittie Keiffer – No, Keith Eller – No, Kendall Mickley –No, Terry Miller – Yes, Shane Bickel – Yes, and the Motion passed 4-3.

Council discussed the Wheel Tax Discussion and the possibility of changing the ordinance. A Power Point was presented to look at the roads that are in need of repair or replacement. A revised Ordinance will be presented at the May meeting.

Discussion on increasing the LIT rate from 0.9 to 1.1 to be able to add the benefits for dispatchers paid out of PSAP. This will be discussed further at the May meeting.
