## BPW&S RESOLUTION 2022-8

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS AND SAFETY OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA RELATING TO THE DISPOSITION OF A CERTAIN ITEM OF PERSONAL PROPERTY

The Board of Public Works and Safety of the City of Huntington, Indiana ("Board"), in meeting duly assembled, after considering information deemed by it to be sufficient, finds:

WHEREAS, from time to time, and in accordance with Indiana law, the City will dispose of personal property that is surplus and no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fire Department has personal property equipment that is surplus and no longer needed, specifically: a 1990 Spartan, Lil' Gladiator (VIN # 4S7PT9504MC003154) with approximately 37,000 miles, and worth about \$8,000; and

WHEREAS, as it was advantageous in the past and because it is already approved for use by the State of Indiana, the Fire Department is again requesting to use the GovDeals.com auction website to sell its personal property; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this Board, as follows:

- 1) The property listed herein is surplus property and is no longer needed by the City.
- 2) The use of the GovDeals.com auction website is approved for the sale of the listed Fire Department personal property.
  - 3) A reserve amount of \$8,000 shall be set on the sale of this personal property.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor, or his appointee, has the authority to do such things and sign such documents as is necessary to implement this resolution.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED this resolution is effective immediately upon its approval.
