WHEREAS, the City of Huntington, Indiana ("City") recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the City has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low and moderate income residents; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the City of Huntington, Indiana that:

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address Stormwater flooding in the southern portion of the City, specifically the Home Place Addition, and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Office of Community and Rural Affairs and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.

<u>Section 2.</u> That the City hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of \$1,824,265 from the City's 2020 Stormwater Bond, Motor Vehicle Highway Fund, and CEDIT/LIT funds, as matching funds for said program, such commitments to be contingent upon receipt of SIP Grant funding from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
