**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SUBSECTION 30.33(A) OF  
THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON CODE OF ORDINANCES**

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Common Council of the City of Huntington, Indiana in meeting duly assembled that Subsection 30.33(A) of the City of Huntington Code of Ordinances be and is hereby amended by deleting said subsection (A) in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

“(A) The regular meeting times and dates for the Common Council shall be at 7:00 p.m. on the second and last Tuesdays of each month.”

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect following its adoption and in accordance with applicable law.
