

**ORDINANCE 2-C-26**

*Synopsis: This Ordinance, if adopted, would amend Section 51.063(D)(1) Local Limits of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Huntington, Indiana to remain compliant with the City's NPDES permit and IDEM regulations.*

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF HUNTINGTON, INDIANA BY AMENDING SECTION 51.063(D)(1)**

WHEREAS, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 5 has worked with the City regarding proposed modifications to the City's pretreatment program; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with applicable law and EPA regulations a public notice was published on December 10, 2025 soliciting any public comments relating to the proposed modifications to the City's pretreatment program; and

WHEREAS, no comments have been received.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT, the Common Council of the City of Huntington, Indiana, in meeting duly assembled, after consideration and deliberation deemed by it to be sufficient, hereby amends the following section of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Huntington, Indiana as follows:

Section 51.063(D)(1) is hereby amended by including and/or replacing the following list of pollutants and limits:

<b>Pollutant</b>	<b>Limit</b>
<b>Ammonia</b>	<b>97 mg/l</b>
<b>Chromium, Total</b>	<b>3.73 mg/l</b>
<b>Mercury</b>	<b>ND*</b>
<b>Molybdenum</b>	<b>1.9 mg/l</b>
<b>Selenium</b>	<b>0.263 mg/l</b>
<b>Zinc</b>	<b>1.72 mg/l</b>

\*Monitoring for mercury shall be in accordance with the following test methods. The discharge of mercury at or above the quantification level of 0.2 ug/l shall represent an exceedance of the local limit. Mercury sampling procedures, preservation and handling, and analytical protocol for compliance monitoring shall be in accordance with U.S. EPA Method 245.1, unless screening using Method 1631 is required by the City. The quantification level shall be 0.2 ug/l for Method 245.1 or 0.5 nanograms/liter (ng/l) for Method 1631, unless higher levels are appropriate due to sampling matrix interference.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED THAT, this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its adoption and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.
